
ADELAIDE COMETS

In 2024, Adelaide Comets celebrates its' 30th Anniversary and there has been significant changes on and off the pitch during this time. In the first instalment of ADELAIDE COMETS IN THE MAKING, let's look back at the changes in the CLUB LOGO over the years.



Formed in 1994, as the Adelaide Raiders Soccer Club, the original club logo was a shield style emblem depicting a Greek Spartan warrior. The Greek flag was depicted in the shield to represent our heritage.

In 1999 the logo was updated to a circular design. The Greek flag on the warrior shield was replaced with our iconic black and blue stripes. This not only represented our home jersey, but was a better fit given the diverse backgrounds of our players and members.

2001



In 2001, the Club changed it's name to Adelaide Comets, and with this came a new logo. An oval design, it was radically different to previous logos, giving a more modern, dynamic edge to our Club.

2017

In 2017, the Club's current logo was introduced. The shape of the logo represents the Spartan shield. The blue stripes on black background represent our home jersey colours. Rising above the 'T' is a comet, also taking the shape of a Spartan sword.

This year, the Club's celebrates it's 30th Anniversary with a Commemorative emblem. This insignia represents our history, illustrated by the Greek Spartan warrior.


