Established in 2014 by Miniroos Coordinator, John Politis, Director of Football, Doug Paterson and Junior Development Officer, Chris Ikonomopoulos, the School of Excellence was an elite program for the Club's Under 12 players.







In 2014, 15 players joined the program, which was aimed at developing players skills and knowledge, but also their love of the game. Players attended skills and development sessions in addition to their existing team trainings.


