2016

The Comets Amateur Teams transitioned from the SAASL into Division 2 of the CSL in 2016, under the guidance of John Politis.

2048



On the brink of disbanding following relegation in 2017, the Collegiates commenced a full rebuild under new coach and former 1st Team player, George Agalidis. With new found determination, the team finished 2nd in Division 2 and secured immediate promotion into Division 1.

2020



In the second year back in Division 1, we won the Minor Premiership and went on to win the Grand Final, being crowned Division 1 Champions.

2022



After being relegated again in 2021, the Collegiates secured promotion back into Division 1 in 2022, under the guidance of Jonathon Giannopoulos. This proved highly successful, completing the Treble with success in the inaugural Hellenic Cup, the CSL Cup and the Division 2 League Trophy. In addition, two players took out individual awards. Arsene Iribuka made Adelaide Comets history, winning the Division 2 League Best & Fairest and James Grech won the Reserves League Golden Boot, topping off the most successful year in Collegiate history.

2023



In 2023, the team finished 4th in Division 1 and reached the quarter finals of the Cup. The Club had individual success again, with Michael Gallo winning the First Team League Golden Boot and James Grech going back to back and winning the Reserves League Golden Boot, as well as the Reserves League Best & Fairest.
